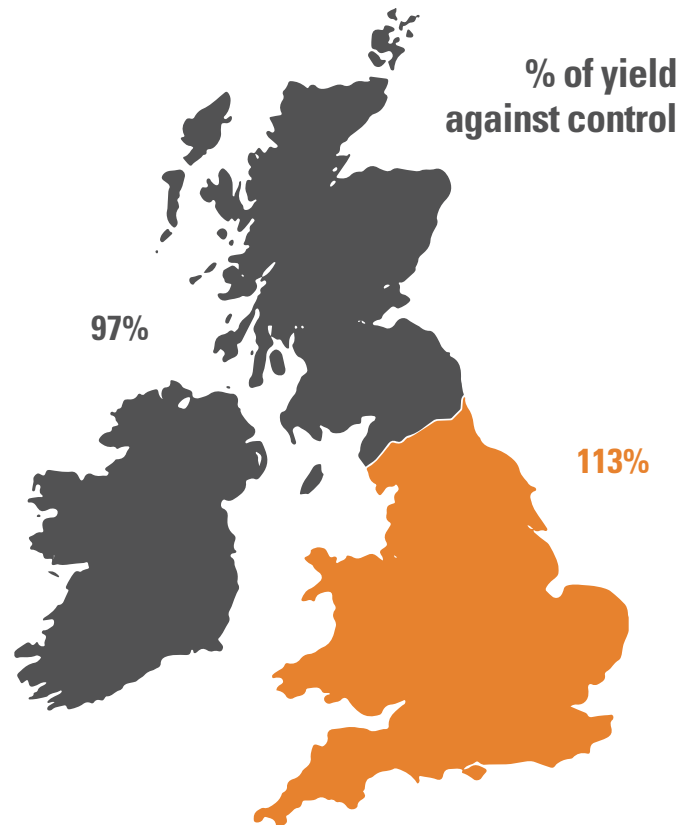
Introducing Tennyson
